### DOMESTIC MILLED RICE PRICES WERE STEADY RICE BY-PRODUCTS MOSTLY STEADY

In the south, long grain rice prices were steady, quoted mostly at 14.75-15.50; medium grain prices were steady, quoted mostly at 14.25-15.00; parboiled rice prices were steady, quoted mostly from 15.50-18.50; second heads were steady; brewers were steady to instances 1.00 lower. Rice by-products: Offers for rice bran were mostly steady, instances 3.00 lower, quoted mostly at 65.00-75.00; millfeed was steady to 3.00 higher; hulls were uneven, mostly steady.

In California, medium grain milled rice prices were steady, quoted mostly at 21.00-22.00; short grain prices were steady; second heads were steady, quoted mostly at 10.00-11.00; brewers were steady, quoted mostly at 9.00-10.00. Rice bran was steady; rice hulls were steady.

**MARKET TONE:** Export prices for most grades of white rice remained unchanged, except prices for fragrant rice which continued to increase. Trade sources reported that domestic prices of white rice fell some because local rice traders and millers released stocks. However, the strengthening Thai Baht (to around 40.7 Baht/US\$, as compared to the previous week's average of 41.2 Baht/US\$) totally offset a drop in domestic prices. Some foreign buyers reportedly resumed their trading activities. Export prices are expected to increase further in the next couple of weeks, following anticipated demand for white rice shipment for Iraq's latest deal.

The surge in fragrant rice prices mainly reflected the government intervention program, where the intervention prices are set at 9,000 Baht/ton (roughly US\$ 220/MT), up from 7,000 Baht/ton (roughly US\$ 167/MT) in the previous year. However, further increases in export prices will likely be limited, as major buyers, such as China, reportedly shifted to relatively cheaper Pahtumthani fragrant rice.

*Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. The authority to report fragrant rice exports was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers from the Board of Trade for non-fragrant and from the Office of Commodity Standards for fragrant rice when available, but the reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.*

Unofficial exports (excluding fragrant rice) for Nov. 1-7, 2004 totaled 177,334 tons, down 57,727 tons from the previous week's total and down 31,523 tons from the four-week moving average of 208,857 tons. Exports during Jan. 1 - Nov. 7, 2004 totaled 6,790,429 tons, compared with 4,318,232 tons during the same period in 2003.

According to the Department of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including fragrant rice) during Jan. 1- Oct. 31, 2004, amounted to 8,311,757 tons, up 39 percent from 5,970,061 tons in the previous year. Despite reportedly anticipated slowdown in Thai rice exports for the rest of the year, total rice exports are expected to reach record 9.7 million tons in CY 2004.

**Rice:** Net sales of 58,500 MT were 31 percent below the previous week and the prior 4-week average. The major buyers were Mexico (11,400 MT), Italy (10,000 MT), Saudi Arabia (7,700 MT), Canada (6,800 MT), and the United Kingdom (5,600 MT). Exports of 58,800 MT were 34 percent above the week earlier, but 3 percent below the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Mexico (11,400 MT), Taiwan (8,800 MT), Haiti (7,900 MT), the United Kingdom (6,900 MT), Canada (5,800 MT), and Switzerland (5,100 MT).
